To Whom it may concern,

Mr. Liubeznov is a 27 years old male who underwent biopsy 4/18/25 and was diagnosed with a grade 2 Astrocytoma. He underwent radiation to the brainstem 5/14/25 -6/25/25. MRI done in 6/17/2026 shows essentially stable disease and improved hydrocephalus. The patient began targeted therapy Vorasidenib on 8/28/25. As his tumor is inoperable and in the brainstem he will likely have lifelong disabilities including difficulty swallowing, vision issues, and intermittent headaches. He will need lifelong medical care.

We kindly request flexibility with the patient's work schedule to allow time off for medical appointments, or in the event that the patient experiences neurological symptoms related to their condition or treatment.
